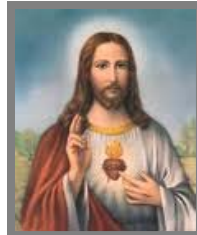

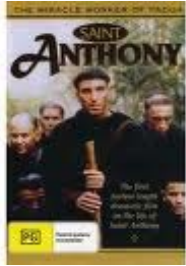

MOVIE NIGHT JUNE 15th After the 7:30pm Mass - St. Anthony - the Miracle Worker of Padua Born into a Portuguese family in 1195, Anthony followed in the footsteps of St. Francis of Assisi and became a humble friar. Anthony was renowned for his powerful preaching, his love for the poor, the holiness of his life and his many miracles that won countless souls for Christ.

La Vita di San Antonio de Padua - Nacque a Lisbona, in Portogallo, verso la fine del secolo XII. Accolto tra i canonici regolari di Sant'Agostino, poco dopo l'ordinazione Sacerdotale passò ai frati Minori per dedicarsi all'evangelizzazione dei popoli africani. Svolse il compito della predicazione con gran frutto in Francia ed in Italia e convertì molti eretici. Fu il primo del suo Ordine ad insegnare teologia ai confratelli. Scrisse celebri omelie, ricche di profonda dottrina. Morì a Padova nel 1231.
